Students have the option of learning additional courses like yoga and several foreign and oriental languages including Mandarin, Spanish, Italian, German, French, Japanese, Sanskrit and Pali. Several spiritual sessions are also conducted at the campus for the benefit of the students and faculty.

The institute houses state of art auditoriums (Nalanda & Takshashila) and an Amphitheatre for various activities, conferences and events.

## Computer Labs

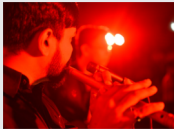


The Computer Center is one of the best equipped IT centers geared to aid the learning process.

## K J Somaiya Institute of Management

Master of Computer Applications (MCA) is a University of Mumbai programme recognized by AICTE. The institute has been training future Information Technology professionals, since 2006. It has produced several merit rank holders at University and has been granted Autonomous status, since 2013. This three-years, six semester programme includes courses from technology, applications and techno-management areas that are in-line with the industry requirements. The MCA programme is facilitated by the Department of Data Science and Technology (formerly known as Department of Information Technology) of the Institute. This helps the programme keep pace with the current trends in the industry. The institute has organized several workshops and hackathon for the students to enhance their coding and other IT/business related skills. Apart from core course, students are provided with value-added courses and are encouraged to opt for on-line certificate courses offered through NPTEL. The institute organizes three flagship events with the help of MCA students namely ICON, Round Table Conference in IT and SICTIM (Somaiya International Conference on Technology and Information Management). The conference helps the students present their research papers which is one of components for completion of their degree requirement. Over the years the Institute has produced several Alumni who currently occupy senior positions in IT and allied industries in India and abroad.

## Kakushin by Nomura Holdings Inc.:

Kakushin is an annual hackathon conducted by Nomura India for past two years (2018 and 2019). It is conducted during the placement season when the company sends invites to top colleges where any IT student can register and apply. ## Annual Conference organised by Area – Data Science and Technology

The pre-conference Workshop on "Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning for Business" was conducted by Mr. Bhagirath Kumar Lader Chief Manager (Business Information System), GAIL (India) Limited on 10th of January 2020. Total 4 sessions, 1.5 Hours each were conducted. The workshop was attended by total 40 participants.

Somaiya International Conference on Technology and Information Management (SICTIM) is an annual conference organised by Area –Data Science and Technology of K J Somaiya Institute of Management inviting students, researchers and practitioners from the field of Information Technology and Management. The conference every year aims at exchanging ideas, enhancing thought processes and capturing the views from designers and developers of technological solution as well as strategist, analysts and users of these solutions with a definite theme in mind.

This year, the 6th edition was successfully organised on Jan 11, 2020 with the theme **"Datanomics – Future of Business"**. There were 20 papers presented during the conference with two dedicated track. Total 4 track chairs, two in each track judged the paper presentations. In first track, the track chairs were Dr. Pooja Raundale (Professor & HOD-MCA – Sardar Patel Institute of Technology, Mumbai) and Dr. Govind Shinde (Professor – Finance – Babasaheb Gawde Institute of Management Studies, Mumbai) and in second track, the track chairs were Dr. Dhananjay Kalbande (Professor & Head, Computer Engineering, Sardar Patel Institute of Technology, Mumbai) and Ms. Saroja Gopal (Director, ATI, DAE, Mumbai.). All the papers were published in the conference proceedings, and can

be later published in the special issue of "Inderscience" journal's special issue titled "Datanomics – The Future of Business".

Chief Guest, Mr. Nadir Bhalwani, Head – Information Technology & Business Process Reengineering, Radio Mirchi inaugurated the conference. Director – Dr Monica Khanna welcomed the gathering while Prof (Dr) D G Jha briefed the participants about the theme and the conference proceedings. Guest of honour, Mr. Neeraj Baveja, Associate Director, Accenture addressed the gathering followed by a question answer session. Dr Kirti Wankhede proposed the vote of thanks.

The opening ceremony was followed by paper presentations. The best paper from each of the tracks were awarded. The student, volunteers and participants with high-level of energy made the conference memorable.





# ICON 2020

Another model was Robotic arm, also known as ARM is a series of robotic arms that were used on the Space Shuttle orbiters to deploy, maneuver and capture payloads. Also there was a Object Recognition based model which is used to map the terrain of planets. The most popular Green screens were also replicated its charm which is used to experience the space in reality through VFX effects.

Students from The Somaiya School were also invited for the event to learn about technology and how it works. Students enjoyed a lot and learned how the actual working of the models happens. Students also enjoyed pre-buzz event in which wirebuzz game, snake and ladder games were present.

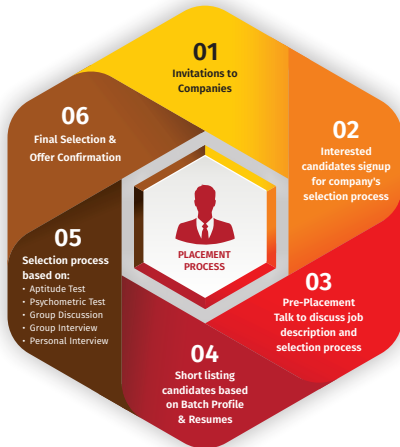
# Placement Process

The last (sixth) semester involves a corporate internship project, which is mandatory as per University of Mumbai norms. Companies can select the students for either the project alone or project followed by confirmed job placements after the six-month Internship.

A 'Pre Placement Talk' (PPT) is expected to be delivered by the company to the students whereby job profiles, career growth path and compensation package is shared by the company. These PPT dates are fixed as per mutual convenience.

After the PPT, the company can conduct their own shortlisting process for the candidates. This is followed by selection process, usually including aptitude test/ technical test/ interview rounds.

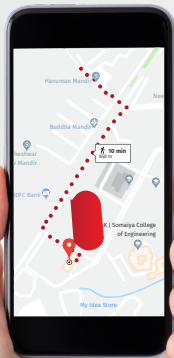
